Oftedal Construction, Inc. was honored in March of 2014 by the Associated General Contractors of America (AGCA) for completing the Togwotee Trail Project. Partnering with the Wyoming Department of Transportation (WYDOT) and a host of federal, state and local agencies, communities and interest groups, Oftedal Construction, Inc. began construction on the Togwotee Trail highway project in the summer of 2008. The project was a complete reconstruction of a 38-mile stretch of highway between Moran Jct, WY and Dubois, WY. Located in mountainous terrain at elevations between 8,000 and 10,000 feet above sea level, the renovation project featured new shoulders, eight new passing lanes, several slide stabilization styrofoam fills, horizontal drains, bridge replacement, wetland mitigation, pullouts for recreational parking and several under-crossings for snowmobilers and wildlife. For Oftedal, the project spanned five years and at \$120.7 million, was the largest construction endeavor ever undertaken in the state of Wyoming at the time. Oftedal is the only Wyoming contractor to ever receive such a nationally recognized award.
